# Stories of Northside

INTERVIEWEES: NORTHSIDE BIBLE CLASS MEMBERS



ne of the best things about walking into a historic library isn't the shelves brimming with novels and tomes, vestiges of authorial wisdom immune to the passage of time. It certainly isn't the grandeur, the smell of paper, or the silence you cannot wait to drink in. It's the feeling you get when you first cross the threshold. You cannot help but sense it: although the room contains thousands of stories, somewhere between the streams of sunlight pouring in through the high windows and the small crevice between each book lies in wait the story of the library itself, a story waiting patiently to be told, shared, and passed on.

You get the same feeling walking into the Northside Bible Sunday school class. Although each member can boast a story of his or her own, the story of the class itself is an amalgamation of tiny moments spanning more than 70 years, moments of love, encouragement, support, loss, and fellowship of kindred minds, hearts, and spirits. This is the story of the Northside Bible class.

Northside Bible was formed in the early 1950's, branching off from the Fellowship Class, Northside's original Sunday school class. The Fellowship Class became too large, and the decision was made to divide the class by age, with the younger members founding Northside Bible, a class that has become a pillar among our congregation. There are still young folks who attend; although, they

may disagree with that. Today, Northside Bible has 37 active and 20 homebound members that are young at heart, and their doors and arms are always open.

Each class begins with a welcome, announcements, and a song or two played on the in-class piano. Northside Bible is currently the only class that still sings. They study from the Uniform Series of International Lessons, and messages are delivered primarily by guest speakers. The best part, however, is the fellowship, according to Nona Young: "The fellowship is just wonderful. Everybody is so warm and so accepting. I cannot sing their praises too high. They are some of the most wonderful people I have ever known in my entire life. Coming to church to worship is very important, but where you get to know people is in the Sunday school class. We just want to create a warm friendly place, a welcoming place.

"Northside Bible members are also incredibly active in the life of the church, and most of their service goes unnoticed. One classmate delivers meals for the church. another delivers altar flowers one Sunday out of the month. One volunteers at the Good Samaritan Clinic every Friday. We even have people who call or visit other members of the class who aren't able to come anymore. Everybody is just as willing as they can to do whatever they can."

The story of this class is too vibrant and rich to contain in a few pages, but each defining moment, self-

sacrificing virtue, and welcoming smile is connected by a single, unifying thread: its closing hymn. Each class closes with voices and hearts raised to the first verse of "Blest Be the Tie That Binds": "Blest other. We are old too!" be the tie that binds our hearts in Christian love; the fellowship of kindred minds is like to that above. Northside Bible's story exists as a bind that ties the hearts of 70 years worth of members together, together in Christian love, together in fellowship, together in Christ.
