Registration Info

Parents must complete a registration form for each child. No registration fee is required.

- Campers 2 years old and younger may choose from Monday/Wednesday, Tuesday/Thursday, or 4-day weekly option.
- Campers 3 years old (by June 1, 2019) and older must participate in the 4-day weekly option.
- Campers 3 years old and older must be fully potty trained.

ONLINE REGISTRATION OPENS JANUARY 23, 2019.

Refund Policy

- Refunds will be issued at 100% on, or before April 15, 2019
- Refunds will be issued at 50% on, or before May 15, 2019
- No Refunds will be issued after May 15, 2019

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When Will I Know If My Camper Got Into Camp?

You will receive TWO confirmation emails:

- Automatically after you submit your registration form.
- The second email will come directly from ShineOn@NorthsideUMC.org within a couple days of registration. In this email, you will be notified of confirmation of days OR if there are any conflicts with the days you selected.

What If I Need to Cancel?

If you need to cancel a camp day or week, you must do so via email at ShineOn@NorthsideUMC.org. If alternate days are available, you may switch days. If there are not alternate days available, refunds will be determined by our refund policy.

Can I Register For One Day Only?

- Campers 2 years old and younger may choose from Monday/Wednesday, Tuesday/Thursday, or 4-day weekly option.
- Campers 3 years old (by June 1, 2019) and older must participate in the 4-day weekly option.
- We do not offer prorated weeks.

Can I Request For My Child To Be With Their Friends?

We do our best to honor special request. It is important that campers are within the same age group in order to be placed together. Keep in mind, that classes fill up quickly and to accommodate your request, register early.

What If My Camper is Sick?

Your camper should be kept home if...

- They have had a fever or has been sick within the previous 24 hours.
- They feel sick
- They are showing symptoms of pink eye
- They are having excessive loose bowel movements
- They have a body rash

If your child experiences any of the above while at camp, you will be called to pick them up. It is very important that you are reachable by phone during the time that your child is in our care.
